Course Descriptions

Half-Day Media Training

This program equips participants with essential skills to communicate effectively during emergencies, focusing on handling media inquiries and interviews. Participants learn to craft key messages for traditional and social media, manage media interactions professionally, and protect the organization's reputation. Through practical exercises, they prepare to handle media communications confidently.

ICS Incident Commander

Participants dive deeper into the pivotal role of an Incident Commander (IC) within the Incident Command System (ICS), mastering incident management and coordination. Key topics include command establishment, situation assessment, objective setting, and resource management. Practical sessions ensure participants are comfortable with essential ICS forms, including 201, ensuring effective incident documentation.

ICS Operations Section Chief

This training focuses on the responsibilities of an ICS Operations Section Chief, emphasizing tactical operations oversight and resource allocation. Participants establish operational objectives, develop tactical plans, and gain confidence in the ICS forms specific to this role. Practical exercises hone decision-making skills under pressure, and preparing participants for this demanding role.

ICS Logistics Section Chief

Participants receive detailed instruction on the role of an ICS Logistics Section Chief, emphasizing efficient logistical support for incident response. Training covers logistical objective establishment, planning, and resource coordination. Through practical exercises, participants develop skills in assessing logistical needs, prioritizing tasks, and making critical decisions. Participants will gain confidence putting together ICS

ICS Planning Section Chief

This program provides comprehensive training on the responsibilities of an ICS Planning Section Chief, focusing on information collection, evaluation, and dissemination. Participants learn to develop Incident Action Plans (IAPs) and coordinate planning efforts. Practical sessions enable participants to analyze information effectively, develop actionable plans, and coordinate planning efforts for a cohesive response.

ICS Liaison Officer - Official Certification

Participants gain a thorough understanding of the role of an ICS Liaison Officer, focusing on coordination with external agencies during emergencies. Training covers establishing communication channels, coordinating information exchange, and documenting liaison activities. Practical exercises enhance skills in maintaining effective relationships and ensuring timely communication.

ICS Safety Officer

This training emphasizes the critical role of an ICS Safety Officer in ensuring personnel safety during incidents. Participants learn to identify and mitigate hazards, conduct safety assessments, and communicate safety information effectively. Practical exercises enable participants to integrate safety considerations into incident response effectively.

ICS Information Officer Awareness

This workshop creates awareness of the Information Officer role in ICS and IMT models, focusing on emergency communications principles, message preparation, and media interview preparation. Practical scenarios reflect operational realities, preparing participants for effective information management during emergencies.

ICS Planning "P"

Participants learn the fundamentals of the ICS Planning "P" process, focusing on creating Incident Action Plans (IAPs) to guide operational activities. Through practical exercises, participants learn to set objectives, devise strategies, and allocate resources effectively, ensuring a coordinated incident response.

ICS PPOST

This program provides comprehensive instruction on using the PPOST framework within the ICS Planning "P" cycle. Participants learn to analyze problems, set priorities, develop strategies, and determine tactics to address incident objectives effectively. Practical exercises enable participants to apply PPOST in real-world emergency scenarios.
